- Setting environmental objectives and targets, measuring and reviewing performance and achieving a programme of continual improvement.



We will at least annually, review our environmental aspects and impacts to ensure that potential hazards and risks to the environment are identified and that suitable and effective preventive and control measures are implemented. All JRP staff will be provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, instruction and training to fulfill the requirements of this policy.

The Environmental Management Representative (EMR) has overall responsibility for all environmental matters. The operation of this policy and the associated procedures will be monitored and reviewed on a regular basis in accordance with the JRP Business Management System to achieve continual improvement.
